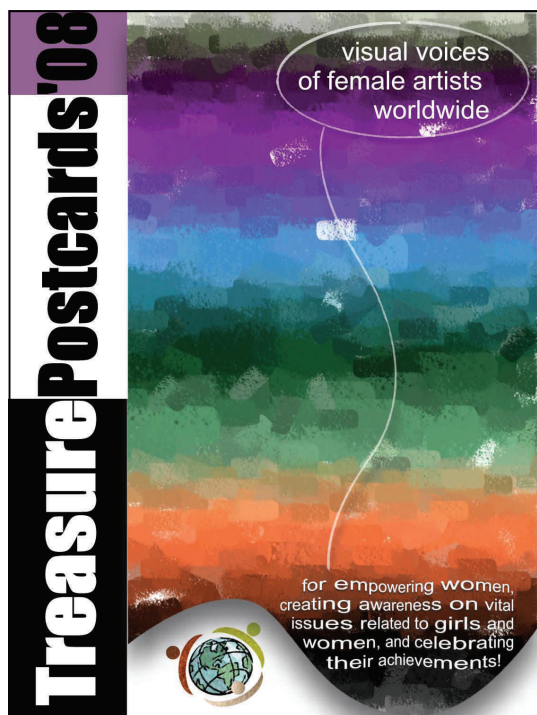
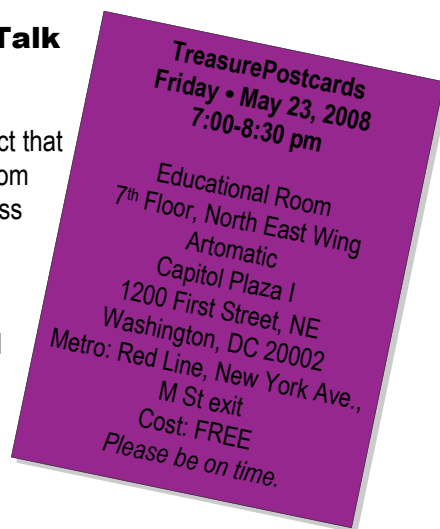


TreasurePostcards: An International Arts Project and Artists Talk
